ORDER ON RESPONDENT'S MOTION TO TERMINATE

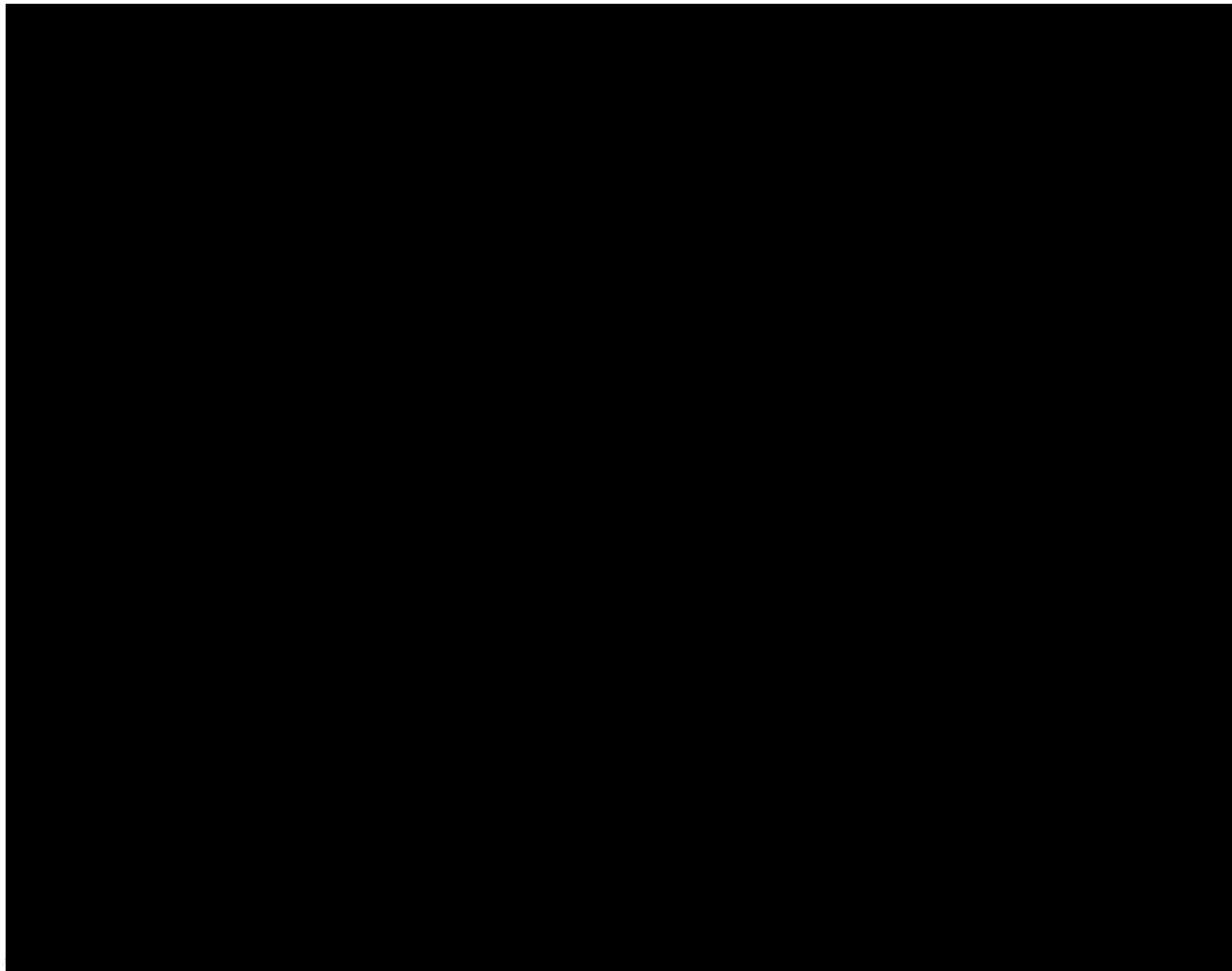

3, 2019, Respondent through counsel, filed a motion to terminate proceedings as Respondent's approval renders the exclusion proceedings moot. *Id.*

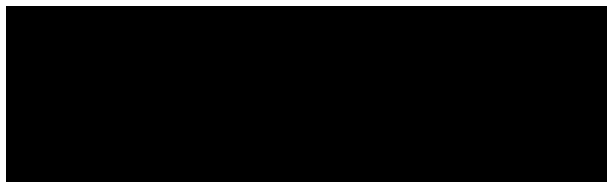
II. Analysis
