Given the deficiencies in the Immigration Judge's decision, we are unable to conduct a meaningful review of the case. *See Matter of S-H-, supra.* We will remand the record for the Immigration Judge to set forth his analysis regarding the respondent's eligibility for relief from removal. Given the passage of time, on remand, the parties should be given an opportunity to present evidence regarding the respondent's applications for relief. The respondent also should have an opportunity to apply for any relief for which he currently may be eligible. Accordingly, the following order will be entered.

• ORDER: The record is remanded to the Immigration Court for further proceedings consistent with the foregoing opinion and the entry of a new decision.
